Day 1. Mon 17 Jun: Homeport - Hervey Bay

This morning we board our coach and make our way to the beautiful Sunshine Coast and the surrounding picturesque hinterland. We ascend the Blackall Range via Landsborough passing the Mary Cairncross Park and then north to Montville, a beautiful village full of charm with a myriad of art galleries, antique stores, fashion houses, gift and antique shops. While here we can purchase morning tea (own expense). We continue to Mapleton where the village flanks the National Park and take in the views from Noosa to Maroochydore. We continue north to Gympie, a historic town that has been heralded as the "town that saved Queensland". The discovery of gold by James Nash back in 1867 on the site of the Gympie Town Hall, attracted over 15,000 men to come and dig for their fortune and the Gold Rush began. We stop and enjoy a stroll around one the towns most beautiful parks or take a walk along the historical Mary Street with its traditional shop fronts. We then visit Gympie's Gold Mining Museum enjoying a light lunch then a guided tour. The museum is based on 5 hectares and has over thirty display areas, there is over 100 years of history to enjoy. We continue our drive north to Hervey Bay and check into our accommodation with time to freshen up before dinner in the resort restaurant.

Day 2. Tues 18 Jun: Fraser

We have an early breakfast before transferring to River Heads for our day trip to Fraser Island. These dunes progress across the island often burying forests and other plant communities. On the other side of the island see the coloured sands which occur north of Eli Creek and comprise 72 different colours, mostly reds and yellows. After a wonderful day out we return back to Hervey Bay and our accommodation at approximately 5.30pm. We have time to freshen up before dinner at the resort restaurant. **Overnight: Ramada Resort Hervey Bay**

Day 3. Wed 19 Jun: Bundaberg - 1770 **Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner** After breakfast we pack our bags and make our way to Bundaberg, the southern most access point to one of the wonders of the world - The Great Barrier Reef. This district is well known for its sugar, beef, tomatoes, avocados, melons and most importantly rum!


