Milford Sound Coach - Nature Cruise - Coach ex Queenstown

Return luxury coach transport from Queenstown to Milford Sound, with an extended two and a-half hour Nature Cruise along the full length of the fiord. (Note May-Sep cruise duration is reduced to 2 hours)

On boarding a Real Journeys luxury glass roofed coach in Queenstown, visitors enjoy a trip along the shores of Lake Wakatipu and through the rolling countryside to Te Anau. The coach driver provides an informative commentary in English only. Interpretation material is available in foreign languages. After a morning tea break in Te Anau, where visitors have the option of purchasing refreshments, the coach continues along the spectacular Milford Road. There is time for photo stops and short walks along the way. Our experienced drivers enjoy sharing their knowledge of the area.

On reaching Milford Sound, visitors board the Milford Mariner or Milford Wanderer for an extended and leisurely two and a-half hour cruise of Milford Sound. These modern vessels, purpose built for operating in a fiord environment, have been designed along the lines of a traditional trading scow, and have real character. These relaxing cruises have special appeal for the independent traveller. An on board nature guide provides detailed interpretation in English only, via roving microphone. There is plenty of time available to explore points of interest and to view the stunning scenery, including waterfalls, rainforest and the towering peaks. Keep a look out for wildlife. Delicious lunch options and complimentary tea and coffee are available during the cruise. Return transport to Queenstown is again by luxury coach providing passengers with time to reflect on the beauty of the afternoon scenery.
