Wynnum Whale Park Morning Tea

Brisbane's oldest water park is a fantastic aquativity playground on the waterfront that packs a crowd on summer weekends. The adjacent tidal wading pool (which varies from waist to knee deep), dates from the Depression era when it was constructed by the unemployed.

Newstead House Guided Tour

Newstead House is said to have taken its name from Newstead Abbey, Nottinghamshire, England, a former Augustinian priory which became the Byron family home. The property was referred to as Newstead until it left the possession of J.C. Wickham in 1859 after which it became known as Newstead House.
